<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We provide children with building skills, application and problem solving opportunities in all areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Partition numbers in different ways. Recognise the place value of a digit in a 3-digit number. Compare and order numbers to at least 1000. Find the rule (sequences) Addition and subtraction. Multiplication using arrays. 	<p><u>Topic</u></p> <p>Children will study the Ancient Romans:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discover which countries were taken over by the Romans and where it all started. Use research skills to find out about Julius Caesar. Be able to describe the life of a Roman Soldier. 	<p><u>Design Technology</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design and construct their own shadow puppet.
<p><u>Science</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light. Notice that light is reflected from surfaces. Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect our eyes. Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object. Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows changes. 	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use 'Hour of Code' to sequence; selection and repetition in programs; work with variables and various forms of input and output; generate appropriate inputs and predicted outputs to test programs 	<p><u>Art</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sketch Roman artefacts.
