Our learning in Autumn 1

- As the children start in the Nursery we will spend time developing the prime areas such as personal, social and emotional development. The children will take part in activities that develop their confidence and enable them to forge friendships. They will read the story 'The Rainbow Fish' and will explore their emotions. We will also introduce the children to the class routines and rules, including the Always Board.
- In Literacy, we will be learning about Nursery Rhymes and All About Me! We will be singing Twinkle Twinkle, Humpty Dumpty and Three Blind Mice. We will be learning how to sing the rhymes using actions and making props. We will be reading the stories 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'
- In Phonics, we will start by learning about Phase One. We will be learning to explore and recognise different sounds and going on lots of listening walks around our new school. Your child will be given their first reading book to practise at home. Please focus on using the pictures to retell the story. Talk about the beginning, middle and end of the book.
- In Maths, we will begin by learning about positional language and how to match and sort objects. We will learn about size looking at the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'.
- In Religion, we will be learning about the dignity of the human person, focusing on the people that love us. We will also be studying ourselves and the importance of our name.
- In Science, we will be learning about our body parts and the five senses.
- In Art, we will be learning about Texture. We will learn how to recognise and use different materials.
- In Music, we will be learning traditional nursery rhymes and practising keeping to a beat.
