Our learning in Spring 2

- **In English,** we will be continuing to form sentences by ensuring we have capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also be learning how to join sentences together using conjunctions such as 'and/but' and we will be adding exclamation marks to our sentences. We will be reading books such as 'Too Much Stuff, Tidy and Someone Swallowed Stanley.'
- **In maths,** we will be continuing with addition and subtraction to 20. We will also be solidifying our number bonds to 10/20. We will also be moving onto place value within 50.
- **In religion,** we will be learning about our community. We will also be learning about the Easter story.
- **In humanities,** we will be focusing on history. We will be looking at Transport and how it has changed over time. We will be looking at when different transport has been invented and how it has changed the way that we live.
- **In science,** we will be continuing our continuing our learning about plants. We will also be starting to learn about animals and ourselves.
- **In art,** we will be learning how to draw. We will be looking at different types of pencils and how to sketch.
- **In music,** we will be learning to perform and looking at notations.
- **In computing,** we will be learning about word processing and how to do basic skills.

In school, we are developing our children's breadth and depth of vocabulary knowledge. In celebration of this, we will be hosting a Vocabulary Parade for World Book Day. We invite the infant children to think of a word and dress up as that word. Nationally, this has proven to be a great success in helping our young children to 'grow' their vocabulary.
